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HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

- Establishing robust arrangements for the management and mitigation of any risks that remain
- Adhering to the relevant standards, statutory provisions and specific requirements of each industry in which we operate
- Providing sufficient resources for the effective management of health and safety including compliance with this policy, and setting and monitoring objectives for continual improvement
- Integrating our supply chain partners into our management systems, ensuring our framework for safe delivery is applied consistently throughout all operations
- Communicating with our employees, supply chain partners, clients to ensure everyone understands how to keep themselves and others safe and healthy
- Training our people to ensure they are competent to carry out their roles safely, and consulting with them regularly on matters of health, safety and wellbeing

It is the responsibility of every individual in the Group to:

- Perform their job in a safe manner, looking out for themselves and their colleagues
- Stop and seek guidance if they believe what they are doing is unsafe
- Report all incidents, near misses, close calls and unsafe acts or conditions
